

## Stations of the Cross

The Stations of the Cross are a 14-step Catholic devotion that commemorates Jesus Christ's last day on Earth as a man. The 14 devotions, or stations, focus on specific events of His last day, beginning with His condemnation. The stations are commonly used as a mini pilgrimage as the individual moves from station to station. At each station, the individual recalls and meditates on a specific event from Christ's last day. Specific prayers are recited, then the individual moves to the next station until all 14 are complete. The Stations of the Cross are commonly found in churches as a series of 14 small icons or images. The stations are

most commonly prayed during Lent on Wednesdays and Fridays, and especially on Good Friday, the day of the year upon which the events actually occurred. Please join us on Fridays during Lent in Church.

The Diocese of Buffalo will begin a 33-day Consecration to St. Joseph on Monday, Feb. 15 that will continue through March 19<sup>th</sup>, on the Solemnity of St. Joseph. This is to mark the 150th anniversary of St. Joseph being named "Universal Patron of the Church" and Pope Francis' call for a Year of St. Joseph, as well as the Patron Saint of the Diocese of Buffalo, our Cathedral and our Church.

Bishop Michael Fisher is encouraging all of the faithful to join together with him in prayer during this very special period of Consecration to St. Joseph.

"St. Joseph provides a timeless example of faithfulness and trust in God, despite uncertainty and even unreasonable circumstances. We would do well to reflect on how his witness might inspire our own as we seek in our day and time to reveal Christ to our world."
